Triple P Programme

TRIPLE P (POSITIVE PARENTING PROGRAMME)

- Prevents behavioural, emotional and developmental problems in children and teenagers
- Enhances the knowledge, skills and confidence of parents
- Encourages self-care for parents

Suitable for parents whose children are aged up to 16 years old

Check list for P1 Orientation:

- 1 Get details of the orientation from the school – they may be doing them virtually this year due to safe-distancing measures.
- 2 Check where to buy books and school uniforms.
- 3 Sign up for the school bus if you need it.
- 4 If you haven't downloaded Parents Gateway, do it to receive timely updates from schools.
- 5 Get a copy of the Parent-Child Activity Book and go through it together!
